(ie guitar – bass amp and drums) (C) Harmonica players: Will be allowed to use their own amps or the amps provided. (D.) For those wanting to use Hammonds, it is your responsibility for the moving and placement to and from the stage area, both before your performance and after. (E.) Drummers: Must use the set provided!
